


## Determining the copyright term of films and sound recordings

The below sets out the general rules for determining copyright in sound recordings or films as of 1 January 2019. However, some older works, such as pre-1969 films, may fall outside these rules because of previous changes to copyright law. \* Important: A film or sound recording is "made public" when it is communicated (eg posted online), published, performed in public or sold to the public with the author's permission. Items that have simply been loaned or have been shared illegally or under an exception (eg document delivery or s200AB) have not been "made public".
